“The idea [to start RecyGlo] came from my own house, where we had household waste in the form of cardboard papers and plastic water bottles. We used to dump them at our courtyard and the garbage collector – who resells the recyclable wastes – rarely comes to buy them. Therefore, the waste becomes a pile unless we get rid of it with Yangon City Development Committee’s garbage trucks. These can have a certain value if they can be recycled but that value is ruined when we inconsiderably litter waste. At that time, I wanted to connect the buyers and the sellers for the recyclable wastes and that is how everything began.”

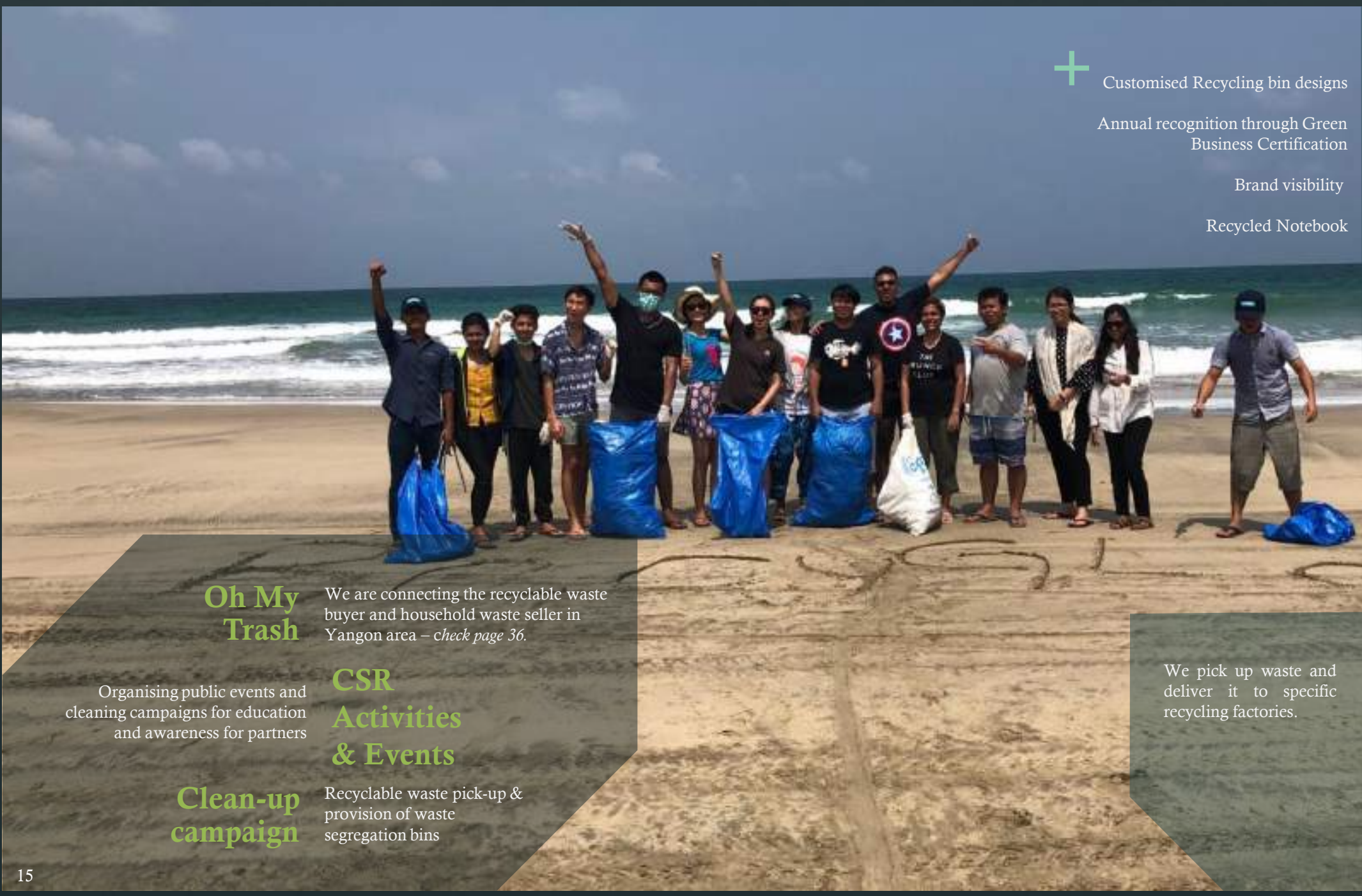

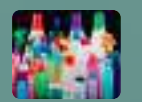

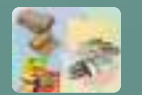

Myanmar Responsible Tourism Awards (MRTA)



RecyGlo is a proud sponsor of the Myanmar Responsible Tourism Awards 2019.

Initiated by the Myanmar Responsible Tourism Institute (MRTI) in 2017, the awards aim to identify the country's most forward-thinking and innovative tourism businesses, to showcase their success stories, and share best practice across the industry. Responsible tourism is about making better places to live in, and better places for people to visit. It involves minimising negative economic, environmental, and social impacts. Also, the MRTA aims to generate greater benefits for local people and make positive contributions to the conservation of natural and cultural heritage.



Inle Rose

This year we undertook the task to advise the company “Inle Rose Waste Management” in enhancing its recycling potential.

Inle Rose is a program launched at Inle Lake to mitigate the ever-rising waste generated by the development of the area. Together with an international development agency that provides services in the field of international development cooperation, we assessed the company on waste collection and handling systems, recycling process flows, and existing recycling operations and market links.

We also assisted Inle Rose with recommendations not only on innovation transfer and technologies in waste management and recycling, but also expanding Inle Rose’s range of customers to additional waste buyers in Mandalay and Yangon.



Neo-recyclable Waste Project

We want to turn low-grade plastics into valuable, tradable products. We will work with a regional partner to transform plastic waste into a valuable commodity. We will use specific machinery to enable low-grade plastics – that are typically not considered in any recycling streams – to become brand new finished goods (i.e. furniture).

We aim to increase the range of plastics we currently can manage and bring a solution to currently unmanageable plastic waste.

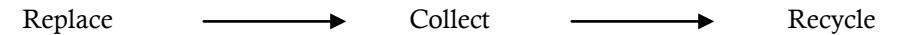


Waste Cooking Oil Project

The incorrect disposal of cooking oil can pose a serious hazardous threat to not only humans but to other living beings and the environment: one litre of waste cooking oil can contaminate a million litres of clean water.

There is currently no solution to waste cooking oil in Yangon and that is an opportunity to build a long-term sustainable solution.

RecyGlo intends to (i) collect the waste cooking oil from restaurants and hotels; (ii) store, pre-treat, and recycle the cooking oil; (iii) export it to international markets or produce biodiesel in Myanmar. Additionally, at RecyGlo we will undertake environmental awareness campaigns so as to educate and inform about the fatal consequences waste cooking oil has in the environment and the people.





Extending our services to individual households



E-waste Management

With the economy growing, the country developing, and the expected consumption of electronic devices rising year by year, Myanmar will soon have to deal with an unmanageable amount of electronic waste. This will be an immense environmental challenge.

Myanmar's total e-waste stood at 52.06 metric kilotons in 2012. Repairing – rather than throwing out – is the current custom: saving old electronic devices and have them repaired when broken.

Additionally, growing wealth and the spread of cheap imports from abroad are expected to lead to more discard of electronics. There is also a lack of basic infrastructures and capacity building activities for e-waste management.

More importantly, e-waste is not regulated in Myanmar and it has not been yet categorised as a hazardous waste.

One-Stop Approach

RecyGlo will soon manage all types of waste and it will be the first company in Myanmar to do so.

We will make sure the E-waste is collected in a safe, non-difficult way and then transported to the recycling expert facilities in Europe, Japan, and South Korea. We place strong emphasis on raising awareness and commit to making the recycling process as transparent as possible.

Customers can find a unique QR code on all of our E-waste recycling boxes which enables them to track their waste from collection, segregation, transport, and recycling stages.

Waste Management Audit & Report

Our Waste Management Report identifies, quantifies, and analyses the composition of the waste stream generated from our customers and areas around to ensure compliance with the requirements suggested by the ISO 14001-2015 requirement, YCDC, and regional environmental agencies in South East Asia.

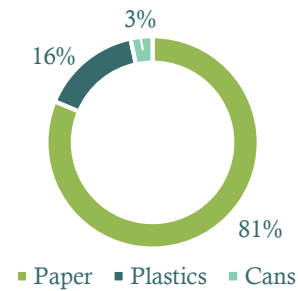
Our audit methodology collects an appropriate sample of waste for the audit through bins placed in designated areas for six months. We analyze and give feedback on the gathered data and our services go from comparing the amount of waste with the number of employees, their behavior, knowledge of waste, and the distinct activities of each company.

The information contained in a report is normally gathered from the on-site collection. Waste audit is performed for six months and analyses the current waste management including waste segregation, waste generation, and waste recycling in the building. We illustrate with figures the collected weight and percentage of each type of waste and the total amount of all the categories analysed in the audit.

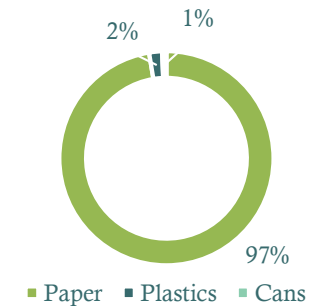
We then publish the results containing the quantity and quality of the recyclable waste in a combination of formats including graphs, charts, and spreadsheets. We include our analysis on trends and we provide our recommendations to improve the waste management at the workplace.

Monthly Waste Audit Waste Composition percentage from July 2019 to October 2019

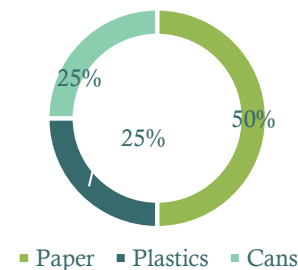
Waste Composition

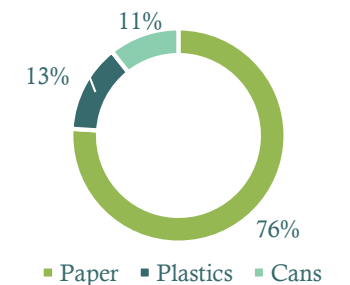
Waste Composition

Pre-sale & Breakeven

We use the pre-sale strategy before we set up the office in different cities. We calculated the cost of opening up a business, operation cost, rent, employees salary and opportunity cost. We conduct pre-sale first until we are break even and then we start serving the market. We recently expanded into the capital of Myanmar using this strategy.

Short to medium-term expansion

All investor money will go far with us. We identify existing support from both private and public sectors. We work together with Magic Accelerator program and Malaysian government to support the market entry into Malaysia which is also a potential entry into the Indonesian market sharing similar language and culture.

We are now working together with ASEAN-AUSTRALIA accelerator and potentially Seedstars into Cambodian market entry. Both Myanmar and Cambodia market is similar and an easy grab for major cities. Good logistics partnership has been secured with jooaak, a reputable logistics startup in Cambodia.

Medium to long-term expansion

If RecyGlo has presence in Indonesia, it opens the door for the numerous funding and growth opportunities: we have several partnerships in the region from Katapult and founders' network for logistics and infrastructure. We are partnering with zero waste lab to be recognized as their portfolio local company before we go into the Indonesia market.

It will also entail a potential exit strategy for the multinationals who want to enter the local and regional market for waste management and recycling plan.

Moonshot expansion

Through our current C2C app “ Oh My Trash” , we want to reach millions within our user base where they can earn extra cash by selling the waste at home. Our platform will allow points to be used for bus tickets, microinsurances, phone credit, etc. Eventually, it will be a super app such as Alipay and WeChat.

While we are building the company, RecyGlo has acquired logistics capabilities through the logistics platform and ecommerce for recycling and resource recovery.

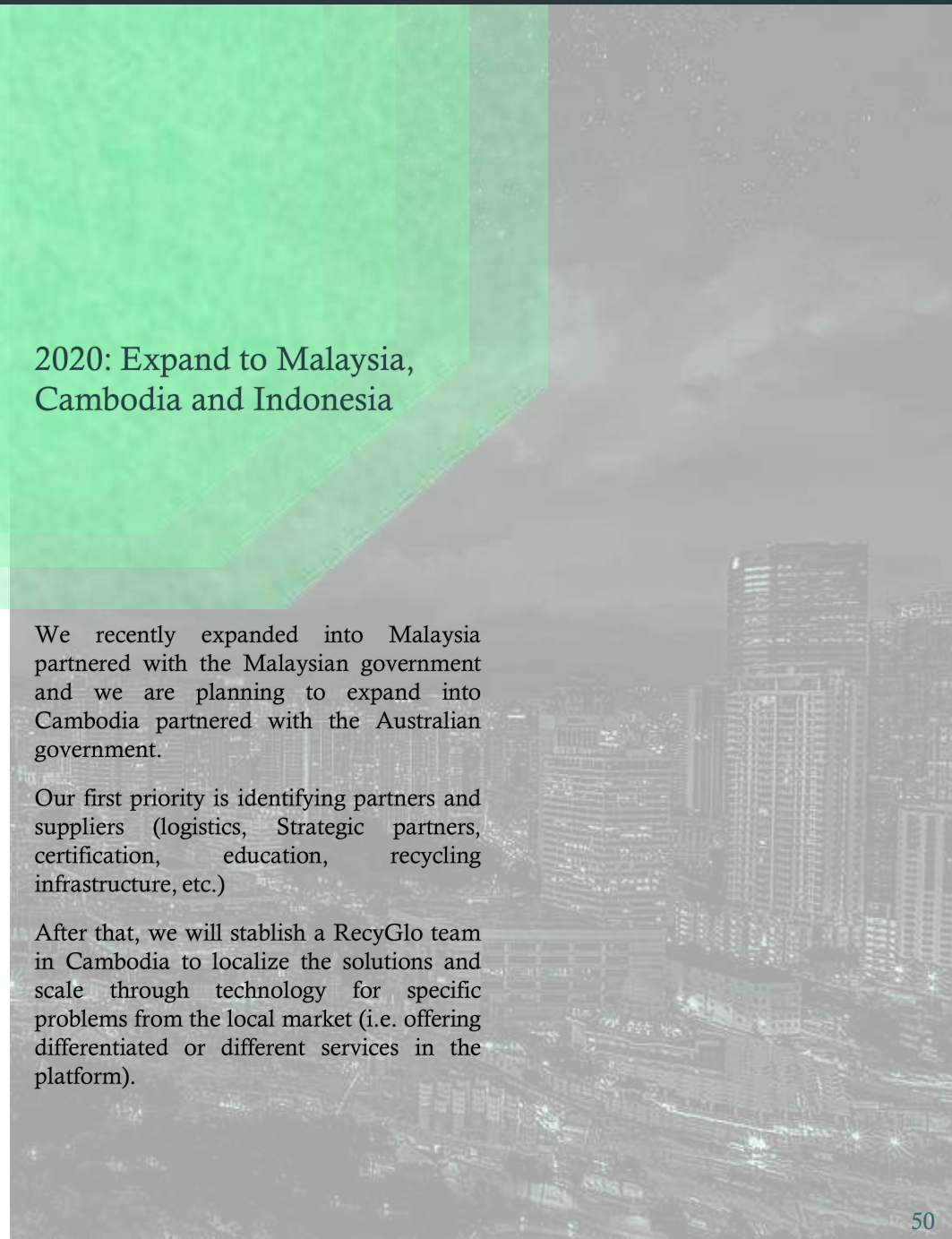


2020: Expand to Malaysia, Cambodia and Indonesia

We recently expanded into Malaysia partnered with the Malaysian government and we are planning to expand into Cambodia partnered with the Australian government.

Our first priority is identifying partners and suppliers (logistics, Strategic partners, certification, education, recycling infrastructure, etc.)

After that, we will establish a RecyGlo team in Cambodia to localize the solutions and scale through technology for specific problems from the local market (i.e. offering differentiated or different services in the platform).

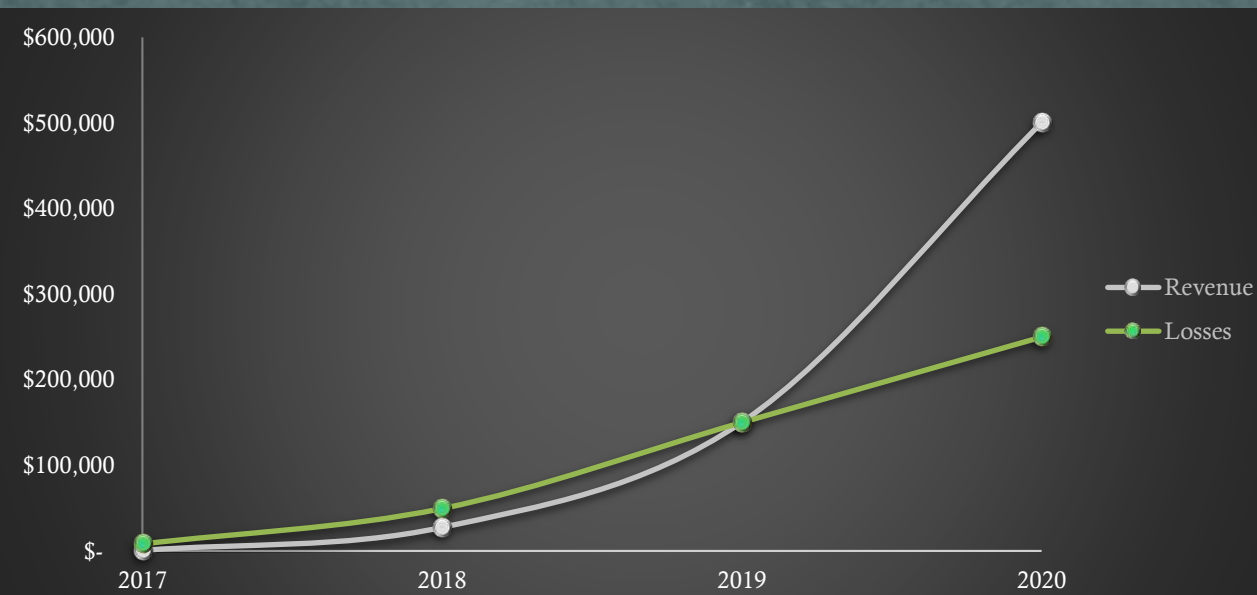

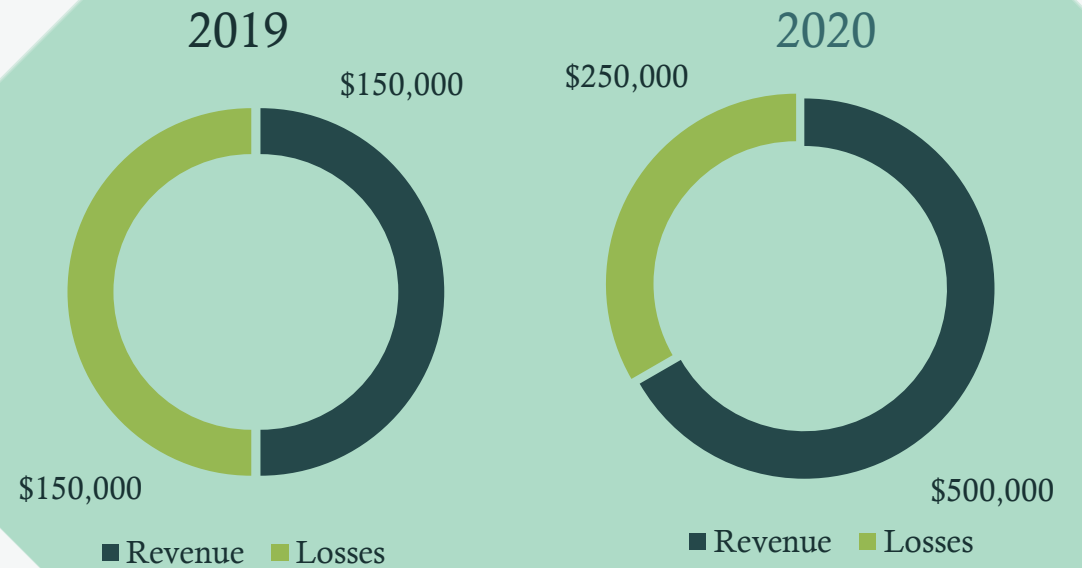

2019 has been a wonderful year for us: we successfully set up ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management for our organization, especially for the back-office foundation; and, RecyGlo was selected as one of the 30 start-ups – out of 1170 applicants from 68 countries – to take part in the Cohort 3 of Malaysian Global Innovation and Creativity Centre (MaGIC) Global Accelerator Programme.
